
Operation

One of the options with the TV66K is the ability to access track on the DV66/68 using the Technovision KEY34 "telephone style" keypad.

Installation Instructions:

- Make sure the power to the player is OFF before attaching the TV-66K.
- Connect the TV66K control cable (RJ10-RJ10) to the KEYPAD port of the player.
- Connect the other end of the cable to connector P1 on the TV66K.
- Attach the optional K34W cable to the back of the KEY34 keypad so that the cable faces down.

BACK OF KEY34



• The stripped back wires from the K34W are then attached to the terminal connectors on the side of the TV66K in the following manner:

	TV66K	KEY34	
Colour	terminal	Pin	Function
ORANGE	10	1	Scan2
RED	9	2	Scan1
BROWN	8	3	Scan0
BLACK	7	4	Return3
WHITE	6	5	Return2
BLUE	5	6	Return1
GREEN	4	7	Return0

Program Operation:

Once the player has been powered on, you can enter as many digits as you like on the keypad – the program will accept the last two digits entered after a set delay. This delay is determined by DIPSWITCHES on the TV66K (see below).

The timeout value is equal to "5" +

If DIP#1 is ON = add 2

If DIP#2 is ON = add 4

If DIP#3 is ON = add 8

If DIP#4 is ON = add 16

A timeout value of 15 equals roughly 1 second.
