### **Description**

The TV-66KPN allows for button access to tracks on various digital players with the track pausing after the track search command. The DV66/68 must be in REPEAT mode for this program to function correctly.

- Make sure the TV-66K is not installed against a conductive surface.
- Make sure the power to the player is OFF before attaching the TV-66K.
- Attach all optional buttons to the TV-66K (see instructions below)
- Attach the supplied cable to the player and connector TS1 on the TV-66K controller.

## **Dipswitch Settings**

1 ON = DV66 STARTUP delay (default). 1 OFF = NO DV66 STARTUP delay (test mode)

2 ON = Same input is locked out (default)

2 OFF = Same input can be chosen again after 3 seconds.

## **Attaching Buttons**

Up to nine buttons can be attached directly to the terminal connectors (#1...#9) on the TV-66K with terminal 10 being the common GROUND.

### **Program Operation**

Upon start-up, the TV66K will send the TRACK 1 and the PAUSE command to the DV66/68 and will then wait for a contact closure between one of the input terminal connectors (1..9) and the GROUND (terminal 10).

Upon sending the track (or NEXT) command, the TV66K will send the PAUSE command to hold the image.
